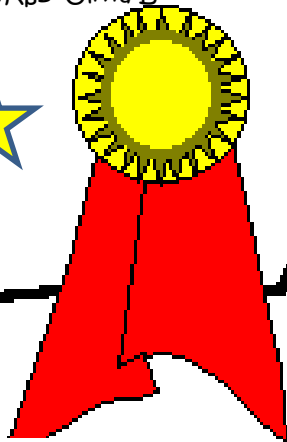

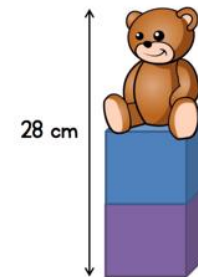

A teddy sits on top of two cubes

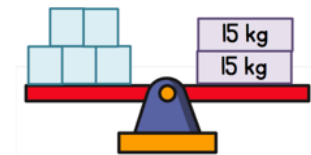
The teddy is 12 cm tall.
