All personal information collected from this questionnaire will be treated as confidential and held securely to meet with data protection requirements. Although individual information is anonymous, the wider information may be collated and shared, (for example information about lifestyle choices and behaviour) with the school and other agencies to improve services and the PSHE (Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education) curriculum. 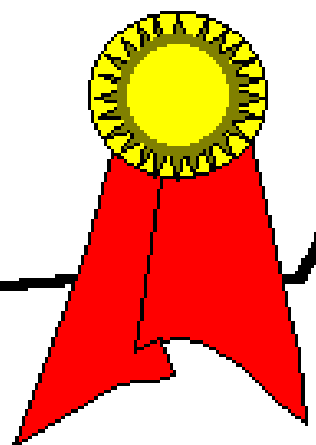

This week, we'd love you to continue spending time with your child practising their number bonds. These are simply the pairs of numbers that can be added together to make a given number. For example, $1 + 9 = 10$, $2 + 8 = 10$, $3 + 7 = 10$ etc.

Have a chat with your child. Do they know their number bonds to 10, 20 or even 100? If this knowledge is secure, your child shouldn't have to work the pairs out, instead they should be able to recall them quite rapidly. How many fun ways can you and your child find to match pairs of numbers to practise number bonds?
