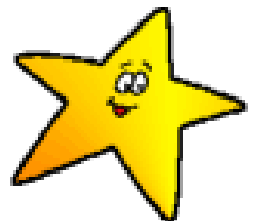

In this topic we will learn about a very important king called Henry VIII, who lived over 400 years ago! We will have a go at Tudor art, music and dance too.

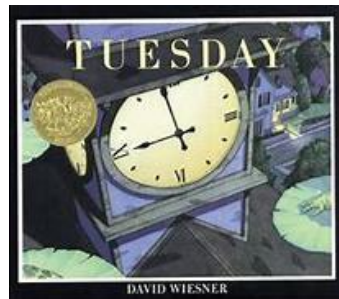
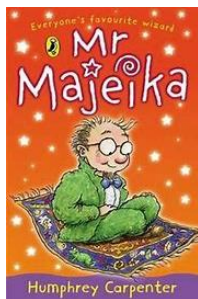
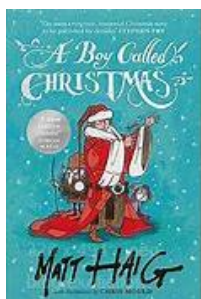


We will cover lots of interesting science topics too, and have a go at many different investigations, just like real scientists!
