Here are some of the fun things we will learn about!

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
## <u>Projects</u>

Discovery



History: Mayans (250AD - AD900) Geography: South American study

Throughout this topic, we will learn about who the Mayans were. Using atlases, we will locate and name countries in South America as well as looking at how close South America is to the equator and why this was so important for the growth of Cocoa beans. In Art we will explore Mayan design and have an opportunity to make your own Mayan Mask out of clay.



History: Romans, Anglo-Saxons and Vikings (55BC - AD1066)

Geography: UK Settlements.

Throughout this topic, we will explore how Britain was invaded by several groups over time. We will learn about the different invaders and how they would have fought fiercely, using hand to hand combat. We will also become archaeologists looking at different objects from the past, to build a picture of how they used to live.

#### Science

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

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We will read some fantastic books together in Year 4. Here are just a few of them:


