Out of School Achievements...

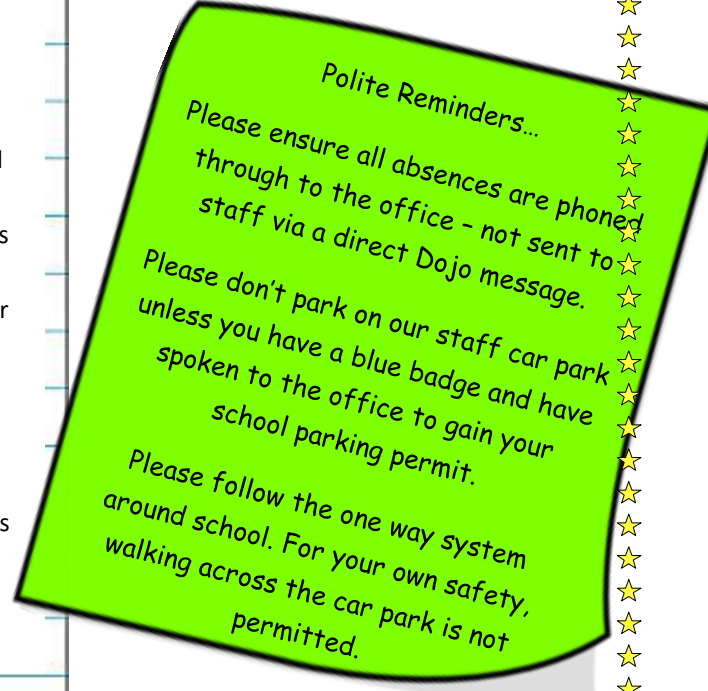
