- In Nursery this week we have enjoyed the 3 Little Pigs story, the children have used the story map to retell the story – they have particularly enjoyed being the wolf! We have helped the pigs to pack their suitcase with items making sure that there are 3 (one for each pig)

- In Year 3, we have really been enjoying writing descriptive phrases and sentences about beaches as part of our class story 'Sand Wizards'. We've also had lots of fun investigating reflective materials in science.
- Year 4 have enjoyed starting our new text Charlie and the Chocolate Factory in Literacy. In WOW writing we have started writing a letter to Mr Wonka to persuade him to give us the final golden ticket to gain entry to his factory. In Science, we have continued to look at Electricity and how to construct our own simple series circuits to light a lamp.
- In Year 5 we have been continuing to read our class novel 'The House of Light'. In science we have been completing research on the solar system and finding out interesting facts about different planets!
- Year 6 have enjoyed learning about some different religions this week. We've also started to design our very own brand new animal species. These will be sent off to enter a nationwide competition and have helped us to learn all about adaptation.

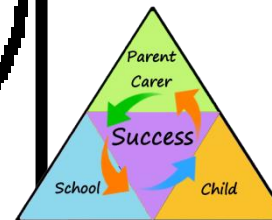
