

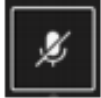
Children - Computer Safety Rules



I promise that :



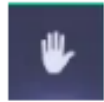
•I will show respect and kindness to all my friends and teachers during my video lessons.

•I will not take screen shots or photos of the screen.



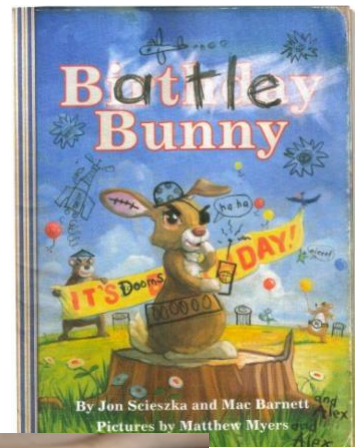
