This Week's Highlights

- Nursery children have listened to the Nativity story. They have been working hard to learn the Christmas songs which we will be recording soon for you to enjoy. We have been visited by 2 elves, one being very cheeky and hides around the nursery each day; the children are very good at finding 'Elfie'!
- Reception started their week with a letter to Santa and began the countdown to Christmas with the arrival of our Class Elves, who have been setting the children a daily kindness challenge. The children have learnt about Advent and how Christians celebrate, the children then created Christingles. In maths the children took part in a Maths Adventure day.
