This Week's Highlights

In **Nursery** we have welcomed 2 more groups of children. We can already see that children are becoming familiar with routines, adults, and other children. We have been listening to stories about starting Nursery and our families and singing lots of songs within the theme of "all about me." The children also took part in a dough gym activity, developing their wrist, hand and finger strength.

This week in **Reception** we have welcomed the final group of children which now means our Reception class for 2022 – 2023 is complete. The staff have been so impressed with how they have all come into school, each day – Well done everyone. We have been learning nursery rhymes, sharing stories, and becoming familiar with our daily routine and school rules. We have been teaching the children to be 'ready to learn', to be 'respectful and to be 'safe'.

This week in **Year 1** the have been reading our focus text – Inside the Villians. We have been finding out all about the big bad wolf to help write out own wanted posters next week. We have also been learning about the UK and have worked really hard to name the 4 countries.

Year 2 have loved reading The Queen's Hat and The Queen's Handbag in our English lessons this week. The places visited in these stories helped us to revise our knowledge of the UK and it's famous landmarks. It was lovely to use these books to celebrate the Queen's life and discuss current events.

Year 3 have had a very busy week! We have started writing our prequels to 'The Dot' in English, as well as taking part in a historical enquiry for our Stone Age topic and sorting natural and man-made light sources in science!

This week, **Year 4** have been working very hard to develop their handwriting and using their new school books. We have continued to find out about electricity and started to learn about how a wind turbine works in order to write our own explanations about this next week.

This week, **Year 5** have enjoyed starting our History lessons learning all about Ancient Greeks. They have been learning just as an archaeologist does, looking at how artefacts can help us find out about the Ancient Greeks! They were fantastic at asking and answering historical enquiry questions.

Year 6 have had a busy week, with some children starting swimming lessons. We have been working on our handwriting to use our new books, as well as learning about inherited and environmental characteristics in science.
