In **Nursery** we have been talking about the feelings of happy and sad, the children have practised showing those emotions on their face and recalling times when they have felt happy and sad. The children listened to the story "Pete the cat and his 4 groovy buttons" and developed their understanding of more and fewer as they compared amounts of buttons.

This week in **Reception**, we have explored the number 3 by counting, adding and comparing amounts. Using the Autumn items collected as part of homework, we have been learning about Autumn. We created leaf drawings using pastels, developing our line and shading skills. We also had our very first official Forest School session – it was so much fun!

This week in **Year 1** have blown us away with their maths work. They have all worked hard to compare numbers and have used the greater than, less than and equal to signs to help!

**Year 2** have enjoyed learning more about the continents of the world this week and writing some amazing facts in their English books. In maths we have also been so impressed with the children's complex partitioning of 2-digit numbers. A great effort Year 2!

**Year 3** have been exploring the features of Stone Age and Iron Age houses in history and thinking about what it would be like to live in a Palaeolithic cave! In Science we have been learning about what opaque, transparent and translucent means, and using this information to create the darkest cave for our toys!

This week, **Year 4** have continued to learn about the culture of the Ancient Maya, expanding our knowledge to find out about their beliefs, the many Gods they worshipped and the things they believed happened to people after death. We are very proud of the insightful; questions the children asked- Year 4 you are becoming true historians!

This week, **Year 5** have investigated how streamline objects effects water resistance and air resistance. We have also looked at a range of persuasive techniques and wonder how many they may use at home this weekend?

This week, **Year 6** have begun our new geography work about South America. We have used atlases and globes to identify the continent it's in and the different countries that are in it. We've also begun a colourful piece of artwork that is inspired by a South American artist called Romero Britto. I think it's safe to say that our favourite activity this week was our sign language lesson. The children (and staff) absolutely loved it.
