

This Week's Highlights

In **Nursery** we have continued to learn about celebrations – we were very excited to talk about our own experiences of Hallowe'en, sharing our photographs from home. We also learned about Bonfire night, talking about what we can see and hear as we watched a video clip of fireworks. We also learned how to keep safe on Bonfire night and many of us are looking forward to celebrating with our families.

This week in **Reception**, we started by looking at the celebration of Halloween. We discussed various traditions and ways people celebrate. In provision, we carved pumpkins, created spooky pictures and tried hard not to make Frankenstein buzz in an 'Operation' style game. With it being Bon-Fire Night on Saturday, the children enjoyed learning about this celebration and creating their own firework picture using paint.

This will help us when we write our own stories this half term! In maths, we have looked closely at fact families and can now write calculations with increased accuracy!

Year 2 have worked super hard this week to put all of their DT skills into practise and sew their bags together. They look wonderful and the users are very happy that they meet the purpose they were created for. The children have also enjoyed using their imaginations to imagine a perfect day in Australia to write a diary entry about!

Year 3 have worked so hard this week, practising the column method for addition and subtraction in maths and writing expanded noun phrases in English. They have also created some fantastic Stone Age inspired cave art to be displayed in our corridor!

This week, **Year 4** have enjoyed finding out about the differences between formal and informal letters as we prepare to read a collection of fictional letters from WW1 next week. The children have learned how to structure/set out a letter and looked at the different ways in which we end formal letters and those written to people we know.
