his Week's Highlights

In **Nursery** the children have been learning about the artist, Guiseppe Archimboldo and looked at how he created portraits using fruit and vegetables. Over the past couple of weeks, the children have explored and learned the names of a variety of fruit and vegetables and used images of fruit and vegetables to design different faces. They then developed the skill of printing with paint to create a portrait.

This week in **Reception**, we have continued to learn our letter sounds and practise our letter formation. In maths, we have been using a Hungarian number square to explore numbers to five. We have also begun to learn songs for our Christmas Nativity and we have discussed which parts the children would like to play. We have tried to make sure all the children are happy with their part.

This week in **Year 1** we have been planning our story. We have loved using our imagination to think up characters and the settings where our story will take place. In maths we have worked hard on fact families. We have explored toys from our past and planned how we will make a festive treat in DT.

Year 2 have worked hard this week to apply their number bond to 10 knowledge to different addition calculations in order to calculate the answer instead of counting the answer. The children have also really enjoyed our trip to Manchester Airport where we learned all about planes and how they work today and even got to test out being a pilot in the cockpit!

This week in **Year 3** we have had a very busy week! We have completed our non-chronological reports on the Mallodile in English, and we have been perfecting column subtraction with exchanges in maths. In geography we have been naming and locating the counties in the North-West of England and we've also been doing a spot of sewing in DT!

This week, **Year 4** have enjoyed exploring the continent of Europe through using their atlas skills, group research and our fabulous new interactive globes-thanks Friends of Allanson Street! We are also continuing to develop our cricket skills and this week everybody learned some key fielding techniques.

This week, **Year 5** have enjoyed starting learning about Multiplication in Maths. We have been working really hard in using high level vocabulary during our lessons: product, factors and composite numbers. In Science, we have enjoyed learning about the different planets in space and their order from the Sun!

This week, **Year 6** have been learning about osmosis and diffusion, in science. They have carried out an experiment to find out how different solutions (tap water, salt water, cola and distilled water) would affect gummi bears. The children are excited to discover the results.
