his Week's Highlights

In **Nursery** we have welcomed back some of our children from last term and many of our new children. The children have enjoyed exploring their Nursery, finding new things to play with each day and getting to know the children and adults. We are amazed with how well they are getting to know the Nursery routine. We look forward to welcoming the last group of new children next Tuesday.

In **Reception**, we have been so proud of how well the children have settled into their new class. We have been having lots of fun exploring our new classroom and outdoor space and playing with our new friends. In class, we have been learning new nursery rhymes. We have also looked at our similarities and differences, leading us to paint a unique self-portrait. The staff are very impressed with how quickly the children are adapting to their new routines and adjusting to Reception.

In **Year 1** we have had an amazing start to the year. We have explored the season of Autumn. We went on walk around the field to spot signs of Autumn and discussed the weather we expect to see. In English, we enjoyed talking about The Wolf and had fun describing him. We learnt a new song in music and in ICT, learnt what technology means.

In **Year 2** we have had a great first full week learning lots of new information! We have been exploring the countries of the UK in geography, conducted some product research in DT, learned about the suitability of materials in science and began practising some notes on the glockenspiels.

In **Year 3** we have had a lovely start to the school year! We have been reading 'The Dot' and completing lots of writing and art about this. We have also started our new history topic all about the Stone Age!

In **Year 4** we have had a fantastic start to the school year! We have been reading 'The Great Kapok Tree' and completing lots of activities to develop our understanding of the incredible rainforest habitat. We have also revised our Spanish knowledge from last year and begun our new art topic by learning all about the artist Gustavo Ramirez Cruz.

In **Year 5** we have enjoyed starting our next topic in Science: Gravity. We have learned all about our Scientist – Sir Isaac Newton and how he discovered gravity by sitting under an apple tree. We have also enjoyed continuing to share our class novel The Miraculous Adventures of Edward Tulane and finding all about his adventures!

Year 6 have had a great start to the school year. They have thrown themselves into all their new learning. We have begun to read a great book called The House with the Chicken Legs and are using this to inspire us in our writing. In geography, we have begun learning about South America and our challenge is to remember 5 countries there. The children have also enjoyed swimming.


