#### Reading

Please make sure you listen to your child read at least 3 times a week and record this in their reading records.

For those children not yet bringing a reading book home, please make sure you are reading to them as frequently as possible.

## This Week's Highlights

In **Nursery** we have listened to the story "Goldilocks and the 3 Bears", the children were supported to retell the story using the story map. The children thought about the Bears' family and learned about how families can be very different to each other. They talked about their own families and drew a picture; these will be added to our family display in the home corner.

In **Reception**, we listened to the story Leaf Man and made our very own leaf artwork using the leaves and other autumn objects we collected on our homework walk. In maths we have been looking at mass and comparing different weights using the language heavier and lighter. We found out that just because an object is big doesn't mean it will be the heaviest.

In **Year 1** we have been identifying number bonds within 10 by working systematically to find each one. We have also used resources such as part whole models and ten frames to help. In English we have been writing our letters as the wolf to persuade the villagers to let us live with them. We have completed some fabulous pieces of writing!

In **Year 2** we have been recalling our bonds to 10 and 20 in maths and in English we have been busy planning our own comic strip adventures and shown lots of creativity in our ideas. We can't wait to read the completed versions next week! In science we carried out our investigation to discover which material would make the most suitable parachute and used our results to explain why.

In **Year 3** we have been writing spooky nighttime setting descriptions, impressing our teachers with some of the dramatic verbs and adverbs that we were using! We have also been planning an investigation in science to build a light proof den to help our class bears get some sleep.

In **Year 4** we have been planning our own newspaper articles about an exciting camera find! We have also been busy practising column addition and subtraction in our Maths lessons and learning all about the structure of Ancient Mayan society in our history lessons this week.

In **Year 5**, we have been working on our persuasive skills in English. We created persuasive posters to promote Maths Whizz, Reading Buddy and stop littering. Look at the bottom of the newsletters for our winners! Well done In Maths, we have been working systematically and using reasoning to find missing numbers in column addition.

In **Year 6** we have started to write about a very dramatic battle scene from War Horse. We have been showing off our skills in swimming, we were so impressive that the swimming teacher emailed Mrs Dingsdale to tell her how amazing we are. In Geography, we researched some of the indigenous tribes of South America.





