This Week's Highlights

In **Nursery** we listened to the story "We're going on a leaf hunt", listened to Vivaldi's "Autumn" and learned about the season of Autumn as we explored our Nursery Garden and Forest School areas. The children have also been learning about the celebration of Hallowe'en, exploring pumpkins and using describing words.

In **Reception**, we read Christopher Pumpkin and started planning our own Halloween Party on Friday. We wrote shopping lists, created decorations and explored different capacities while making potions. We have been learning about the Halloween celebration and how we celebrate it.

In **Year 1** we have been amazing musicians, playing the glockenspiels. We have been focusing on our number bonds to 10 in maths and enjoyed using this new knowledge to play games. In English, we have started our new book, In The Toy Museum, and after predicting what it will be about and thinking about where the toys could go on an adventure we can not wait to start reading it!

In **Year 2** we have finished making our bags in Design Technology and have amazed ourselves with the progress we have made in our sewing skills. We have started to publish our comic strips inspired by the author Alastair Humphries and will look forward to printing and illustrating them next half term.

In **Year 3** we have been busy finishing our current history unit all about the Stone Age! This week we have been comparing Stone Age houses and settlements to where we live now. In Science, we have been building light proof dens, testing different materials to see which were the most effective at blocking out light.

In **Year 4** we have crammed in lots of learning about classification in Science and the achievements and eventual decline of the Ancient Mayan civilization in history. We have also worked very hard to publish our newspaper reports in English and complete our amazing animal fusion sculptures in art!

In **Year 5**, we signed, sealed and delivered our persuasive letters to Mrs Dingsdale. We hope she enjoys reading them over the half term break and we get a reply soon! In Art, we started our artist appreciation lesson looking at L.S Lowry and his paintings of the industrial district of the North of England. 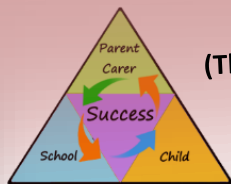
