his Week's Highlights

In **Nursery** we talked about our celebrations of Hallowe'en and Bonfire night. We also learned about Remembrance Day and the significance behind the poppy, we printed our own pictures of poppies to display in our Nursery windows. The children also developed their physical skills by taking part in "Squiggle while you wiggle" dance before using the moves in their mark making.

In **Reception**, we have started to learn about our new topic of celebrations. We spoke about two celebrations we have had recently, Halloween and Bonfire Night. We learned about the 3 prime colours and how we can mix them together to make new colours. We played a new game in maths to help us understand more and less and practise our number skills.

In **Year 1** we have been marvellous mathematicians by using our addition knowledge to answer word problems. We enjoyed hearing our new story and were able to sequence this. We have also enjoyed exploring verbs and Capital letters to create super sentences. In history, we explored how communities came together during the war.

In **Year 2** we have been enjoying publishing our comic strips that we wrote last half term. The children typed up their finished piece of work into a comic strip template and have illustrated them and added speech bubbles too! We have also enjoyed learning all about how lives for children were very different back during World War 1 and the children thought carefully about what they would have wanted to do if they were alive during the war.

In **Year 3** we have started our new geography topic and learnt that England is split into 9 regions. For Remembrance week, we have been focussing on the role of women in the war. We wrote a diary entry imagining we were woman who worked in either a munitions factory or on a farm. In maths, we have started to use the column method to add and subtract 3-digit numbers.

In **Year** 4 we have been reading 'The Last Post' and learning about the life of soldiers during WW1. We have looked at Lord Kitchener's poster campaign, and conditions in the trenches. We have used our knowledge to begin to write a letter from the perspective of a WW1 soldier. In maths we have been consolidating our learning of addition and subtraction of two 4 digit numbers.

In **Year 5**, we have worked really hard on our assessment this week. We are so proud of you all! For Remembrance week, we have been focusing on tactics used during WW1 including propaganda, trenches and morse code to help win the war effort! Our school grounds look beautifully decorated with our bauble decorations which a full of information about the different coloured poppies we wear to remember those who helped in winning the war.

In **Year 6**, as well as working really hard on our assessments, we have been learning about how World War one started. We visited St. Peter's Church and learned how WW1 impacted people in our area. We were lucky enough to meet Albert (92) who told us about what life was like in St.Helens, during World War 2. This was a lovely visit and gave us time to reflect on those people that fought and died during the wars.




