Reading

Please make sure you listen to your child read at least 3 times a week and record this in their reading records.

For those children not yet bringing a reading book home, please make sure you are reading to them as frequently as possible.

This Week's Highlights

In **Nursery** we have continued to focus our learning about the season of Winter and listened to the story – “Here comes Jack Frost”. The children have talked about which events happened at the beginning, middle and end of the story. They have practised their cutting skills, creating a “unique” snowflake and pictures inspired by the Winter theme.

In **Reception**, we designed clothes for Stick Man to help him get back to the Family Tree. We read Snowflake Bentley and learned about how technology has changed and how different cameras are in the present. We have been playing lots of games in maths to help us with our numbers to 5. We have had lots of fun exploring the snow and ice outside.

In **Year 1** we have been finding out lots of information about different animals, including reptiles, fish and amphibians. This information will help us to understand how animals adapt to their environment. We have also been learning about the polar regions, and know lots of interesting facts about the Arctic and Antarctica.

This week **Year 2** enjoyed reading a new English focus text called Burger Boy. The children did a great job identifying catchy hashtags to help them summarise different parts of the story. In science we learned all about how to keep ourselves healthy and enjoyed using dot notation to compose our own music on the glockenspiels.

In **Year 3** we continue to enjoy our Forest School sessions. Although it was a bit chilly on the field this week, we loved being outside exploring all the winter sights and sounds. We have been reading Winter themed poems in English, and have started to collect our own ideas, using our senses, ready to write our own poems next week.

In **Year 4** we have enjoyed listening to the story Escape from Pompeii and immersing ourselves in the destruction the eruption of Mount Vesuvius caused. We have also started to learn about the Roman invasion of Britain in our history lessons by examining a range of historical artefacts and making deductions about their uses.

In **Year 5**, we have worked extremely hard in maths and are becoming much more confident in ordering fractions with different denominators. The children have shown resilience and have been able to use prior knowledge of equivalent fractions to help them complete tasks. We have also enjoyed being archaeologists and have explored range of artefacts relating to our history topic.

Year 6: We have loved learning all about the skills we need to work with clay and using different techniques to make a Viking Warrior mask. We have discussed forgiveness and purpose in R.E lessons and started to discover the exciting world of drama and tragedy within Romeo and Juliet.

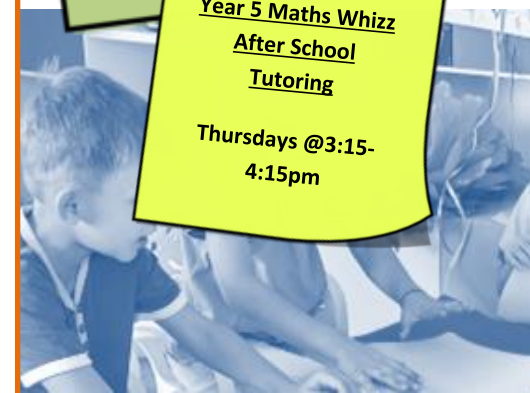
Reminders
