

Reading

Please make sure you listen to your child read at least 3 times a week and record this in their reading records.

For those children not yet bringing a reading book home, please make sure you are reading to them as frequently as possible.

This Week's Highlights

In **Nursery** we have focused our learning on the story "We're going on a Bear Hunt". The children have recounted the story by reading the story map and using actions to help them to remember the sequence. The children talked about their bedtime routine, thinking about what they did first, next etc and considered what the bear from the story may do. They listened to 2 pieces of music and discussed why they may be suitable to help the bear to go back to sleep, deciding on 'Brahm's lullaby'.

In **Reception** we have been visited by two aliens who had crashed landed in our classroom!! We talked about where they might have come from and learned about Neil Armstrong and his mission to the moon. We practised our skill of collaging by collaging our own planets for the aliens. In Maths we looked at weighing items and seeing whether they are heavier or lighters depending on whether the scale went up or down. Then we practised balancing different items using cubes.

In **Year 1** we have used our map skills to plot a journey across Antarctica in Geography. In English, we have used our knowledge of polar bears to create a fact sheet to provide information for a zoo. In maths we have been using our knowledge of the numbers to 20 to answer a range of questions. We had so much fun in art, exploring water colours and creating textures to provide a background for our collages.



We have also started a new topic in maths learning all about multiplication and division.

In **Year 3** we have started a new science topic, all about humans and animals. This week, we were thinking about the different food groups such as carbohydrates and protein, and why they all play an important part in our diet. We are whizzing through our multiplication unit in maths, practicing our 4 and 8x tables this week!

In **Year** 4 we have enjoyed a fantastic trip to Chester where we learned lots of interesting information about the Romans and how they founded the city. We have also been working hard in Science to develop our knowledge of the digestive system and in English we are writing a diary entry in role as a survivor of the deadly Pompeii earthquake!

In **Year 5**, we have consolidated our understanding of fractions and are enjoying our new multiplication unit. In English, the children have really enjoyed reading the text Cosmic and are loving how the author has added humour. The children have had a fantastic end to the week enjoying a range of activities planned for number day.

Year 6: We have really enjoyed completing the maths activities for number day and shown that we can work well as a team to face a challenge. We sketched out our final design plans for our mythological sculptures in art and composed our own pieces of music.
